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Criteria

To recognize individuals who have contributed to our sport particularly within, the Michigan Soccer Association (M.S.A.). Candidates shall be nominated in any of these categories:

Player:

1. Must be in good standing with the leagues, the M.S.A., the United States Adult Soccer Association (U.S.A.S.A.), and the United States Soccer Federation (U.S.S.F.).
2. An outstanding player in their era.
3. Not actively playing unless over 50 years of age.
4. Must have played in the M.S.A. affiliated teams at least 15 years and have been a member of a championship team, State Cup Finalist, National Cup Finalist, a member of the United States Adult Soccer Association Select Team, or a member of the United States National Team.
5. Shall have exhibited attributes of teamwork, advanced skills, fair play, and respect for the game and other players.

Coach:

1. Must be in good standing with the leagues, the M.S.A., the U.S.A.S.A., and the U.S.S.F.
2. Shall have coached in the M.S.A. affiliated teams at least 15 years.
3. Shall have exhibited exceptional coaching and teaching abilities and or coaching success.
4. May have contributed in other ways to enhance, and promote, the positive image of coaching in the M.S.A.
5. Shall have attended coaching clinics offered by the M.S.A., the U.S.A.S.A., the U.S.S.F., etc.

Administrator:

1. Must be in good standing with the leagues, the M.S.A., the U.S.A.S.A., and the U.S.S.F.
2. May have served as M.S.A. officer or league administrator and in these capacities rendered exceptional service to adult amateur soccer for at least 20 years.
3. Those who, apart from these capacities, have by their assistance, sponsorship or other valuable contribution furthered the development of adult amateur soccer in Michigan.

Meritorious Service:

1. Must be in good standing with the leagues, the M.S.A., the U.S.A.S.A., and the U.S.S.F.
2. May be retired from soccer for 1 year except over 55 or deceased.
3. Should be based on contribution to M.S.A. or the sport in general.

Referees:

1. Shall have served as a referee, instructor, assessor, or assigner for at least 15 years for the M.S.A. affiliated teams.
2. Shall be recommended by the S.R.A. and the M.S.A. President.
